Set sail on a traditional felucca, drifting along the Nile under the stars. In Luxor, uncover the wonders of Karnak Temple, the Valley of the Kings, and the towering Colossi of Memnon. Enjoy cultural encounters, including a visit to Animal Care in Egypt and a Nubian dinner experience. Return to Cairo for a deep dive into Islamic history at Bab al-Futuh and Khan al-Khalili Bazaar. With a blend of adventure, history, and local traditions, this trip offers an unforgettable glimpse into Egypt's rich heritage.

Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Ahlan wa sahlan! Welcome to Egypt. If you arrive early, explore Cairo's lively bazaars, visit Dr. Ragab's Pharaonic Village, or enjoy a warm, nutty **sahlab**. Your adventure officially begins with a

welcome meeting at 6 PM. Afterward, join your fellow travelers for a delicious plate of **koshari**, Egypt's beloved vegetarian dish. If you're in the mood, discover Cairo's vibrant nightlife with your trip leader.

Day 4

The Pyramids & Sleeper Train to Aswan

Start your day with breakfast before heading to one of the world's most iconic landmarks—the **Great Pyramids of Giza**. Stand in awe of these 4,500-year-old wonders and visit the **Sphinx**, still guarding the desert despite its missing nose. You'll have time to take in the scale of the pyramids up close or capture the perfect photo with the Cairo skyline in the background. The rest of the day is free for exploration—perhaps visit the **Egyptian Museum** or the **Valley Temple of King Khafre**. In the evening, board your overnight sleeper train to Aswan.

Day 3

Exploring Aswan

Arriving in Aswan, start your day with a walk through its bustling **bazaar**, where you can browse spices, perfumes, and handicrafts. Visit a local oil and perfume merchant to learn how aromatic botanicals have been used in Egypt for centuries. Later, enjoy a **kayaking adventure** on the Nile, offering a unique way to experience the river's timeless beauty. In the evening, consider an optional visit to a **Nubian village** for a traditional dinner with a local family.

Day 4

Free Day in Aswan

Today is yours to explore Aswan at your own pace. If you're up for an early start, consider visiting **Abu Simbel**, an awe-inspiring temple complex carved into the cliffs by Pharaoh Ramses II. If you prefer a more relaxed day, visit the **Nubian Museum** or take in the sights along the Nile with a cup of mint tea.

Day 5

Felucca Sailing on the Nile

Enjoy a relaxed morning before boarding your **traditional felucca**, a wooden sailing boat used by Egyptians for centuries. Glide along the Nile, take in the serene landscape, and spend the afternoon reading, playing games, or simply enjoying the peaceful waters. As night falls, settle in for a unique **sleeping experience under the stars**, accompanied by local music and a cozy dinner on deck.

Day 6

Journey to Luxor

Disembark the felucca and refresh with a well-earned hotel shower. On the way to **Luxor**, you may opt to visit **Edfu Temple**, one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt. Upon arrival, explore **Karnak Temple**, a vast ancient complex filled with towering columns and intricate hieroglyphics. If you're feeling adventurous, circle the famous granite scarab near the Sacred Lake seven times—it's said to bring good luck!

Day 7

Valley of the Kings & Sleeper Train to Cairo

Start your morning with a visit to the **Valley of the Kings**, where ancient pharaohs, including Tutankhamun, were laid to rest. Continue to the **Colossi of Memnon**, two towering statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. You'll also stop at **Animal Care in Egypt (ACE)**, an organization providing free veterinary care for working animals. If time allows, you can explore the **Hatshepsut Temple** or visit **Luxor Temple** before boarding the overnight train back to Cairo.

Day 8

Exploring Cairo

After arriving in Cairo, freshen up at your hotel before heading out to explore **Islamic Cairo**. Take a metro ride with your leader to **Bab al-Futuh**, one of the remaining gates of the Old City. Wander past historic mosques and monuments before entering the lively **Khan al-Khalili Bazaar**, where you can practice your haggling skills. Don't miss a stop at **El Fishawy**, a legendary café serving tea for over 240 years. Enjoy a free evening to celebrate your journey with a farewell dinner or explore Cairo's nightlife one last time.
