Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Day 2

Giza Pyramids & Grand Egyptian Museum

Begin at the Giza Pyramids, where you'll explore the iconic Great Pyramid of Khufu, the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure. Marvel at the Great Sphinx, the ancient statue with the body of a lion and the face of a pharaoh, guarding the pyramids for thousands of years. You'll also visit the Valley Temple, where rituals and mummifications took place, capturing impressive views of this remarkable landscape for an unforgettable experience.

Enjoy lunch at a quality local restaurant.

Next, journey to the Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM), one of the world's largest and most modern museums, designed to showcase Egypt's ancient treasures. Enjoy the museum's incredible collection of statues, artifacts, and royal treasures from various dynasties. Fly from Cairo to Luxor - Luxor Day Tour

After enjoying breakfast, you will be transferred by a private air-conditioned vehicle to Cairo Airport to take your flight to Luxor.

Upon arrival, our representative will greet you at the Luxor airport and accompany you by a private A/C vehicle for an unforgettable experience in Luxor City.

Your day begins on the East Bank with a visit to Karnak Temple, the largest temple complex in Egypt and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore its vast precincts, marvel at the towering columns of the Hypostyle Hall, and discover the intricate inscriptions that celebrate the reigns of many pharaohs.

Next, you'll visit Luxor Temple, a stunning temple dedicated to the Theban Triad, with its magnificent granite statues of Ramses II standing guard at the entrance. The temple's open courtyard and towering obelisks provide breathtaking photo opportunities.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant before heading to the West Bank to continue your tour.

On the West Bank, your first stop is the Valley of the Kings, where you can explore the elaborately decorated tombs of ancient Egyptian pharaohs, including intricate wall carvings that have withstood thousands of years.

Next, you will visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, a grand structure carved into the cliffs of Deir el-Bahari, built to honor one of Egypt's most famous female pharaohs. Explore the temple's impressive terraces and colonnades, offering a striking view of the surrounding desert landscape.

Finally, you will visit the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous statues of the pharaoh Amenhotep III, which once flanked the entrance to his mortuary temple.

Day 4

Transfer to Aswan - Aswan City Tour

After breakfast, you will transferred by a private A/C vehicle to the train station for your journey to Aswan.

Upon arrival in Aswan, our expert Egyptologist tour Guide will meet you at the train station and accompany you to enjoy your city tour in Aswan.

Your first stop is the Aswan High Dam, an engineering marvel that controls the flow of the Nile River and provides irrigation for much of Egypt. From here, you will enjoy a panoramic view of Lake Nasser, one of the world's largest artificial lakes.

Next, you'll visit the Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis. This temple complex was moved to Agilkia Island after the construction of the High Dam, ensuring its preservation. You'll marvel at the temple's beautiful reliefs, depicting the ancient myths and legends of Egypt.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

After a full day of exploration, you will be transferred to your hotel.

Day 5

Abu Simbel Tour from Aswan by Car

After breakfast, you will depart from your hotel in Aswan with our tour guide for a day trip to Abu Simbel, located about 3 hours south of Aswan.

Abu Simbel is home to the magnificent temples of Ramesses II and his queen, Nefertari. The temples are carved into the mountainside and are famous for their colossal statues of the pharaoh. The Major Temple, dedicated to Ramesses II, features four enormous statues at the entrance, each over 20 meters

tall. Inside, the walls are adorned with scenes of Ramesses' military victories. The Minor Temple is dedicated to Queen Nefertari and is equally impressive, with six statues of the queen and her husband, showcasing their powerful and harmonious relationship.

After exploring this incredible UNESCO World Heritage site, you will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

After the tour, you will be transferred to Aswan Airport to take your flight back to Cairo.

Upon arrival in Cairo, our representative will meet you at the airport and accompany you to your hotel.
