Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival in Cairo **Welcome to Egypt!** Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, our representative will greet you and assist you to your private air-conditioned vehicle. Transfer to your hotel for check-in and relaxation.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum & Overnight Train to Luxor

Begin your day with a guided tour of two of Egypt's most iconic and historically significant landmarks. Your expert guide will provide fascinating insights into the ancient world as you explore these world-renowned sites:

Egyptian Museum: Discover the treasures of ancient Egypt at the world's largest archaeological museum, Admire the museum's stunning architecture, which perfectly blends modern design with the grandeur of Egypt's history.

Enjoy a flavorful Egyptian lunch at a local restaurant.

Giza Pyramids & Sphinx: Visit the awe-inspiring pyramids, the only remaining Wonder of the Ancient World. Stand in the shadow of the Great Pyramid and learn about the incredible engineering that has preserved these monuments for thousands of years. Finish your visit with a stop at the enigmatic Sphinx, a massive statue carved from a single block of limestone.

In the evening, transfer to Giza Railway Station for an overnight train to Luxor (approximately 13 hours).

Day 3

Luxor – Karnak Temple

Upon arrival in Luxor, head straight to the Karnak Temple Complex:

Karnak Temple: Step into the largest religious complex ever built, dedicated to the god **Amun-Ra**. Wander through the **Hypostyle Hall**, a forest of 134 massive columns, and admire the towering obelisks, sacred lake, and intricate carvings that depict ancient rituals and pharaonic achievements.

The afternoon is yours to relax at your hotel or explore the city at your leisure.

Day 4

Luxor – Valley of the Kings & Transfer to Aswan

After breakfast, Start the day with a journey across the Nile to the Valley of the Kings:

Valley of the Kings: Explore the burial site of Egypt's greatest pharaohs, including Tutankhamun, Ramses II, and Seti I. Descend into the elaborately decorated tombs, adorned with vivid hieroglyphs and scenes from the Book of the Dead, which guided the pharaohs to the afterlife.

Aswan – Philae Temple & Nubian Village

After breakfast, take a water taxi to:

Philae Temple: Take a boat ride to **Agilkia Island**, where the temple was relocated to save it from the rising waters of Lake Nasser. Dedicated to the goddess **Isis**, this beautifully preserved temple features intricate carvings and stunning columns, offering a glimpse into ancient Egyptian religious practices.

The afternoon is free to relax before an evening trip to:

Nubian Village, where you'll enjoy dinner with a local family and experience their warm hospitality.

Day 7

Aswan - Felucca Sail & Return to Cairo

Rise early for a peaceful felucca:

Felucca sail along the Nile as the golden sun casts its glow on the Sahara.

After breakfast onboard, enjoy some free time before an afternoon flight back to Cairo.
