Day 2

your tour guide and driver will greet you upon arrival. Begin your exploration with a guided visit to:

Philae Temple: Located on Agilkia Island, this beautifully preserved temple is dedicated to Isis,

the goddess of health, marriage, and wisdom. Learn from your guide how this ancient site was

relocated to protect it from flooding during the construction of the Aswan High Dam. Stroll

through its elegant colonnades, intricate carvings, and sanctuaries while hearing captivating

stories about its religious and cultural significance.

In the evening, take a boat ride to a **Nubian village**. Walk through its vibrant streets, visit local

markets, and enjoy a warm dinner with a Nubian family. Share stories, learn about their traditions,

and savor dishes unique to Nubian culture.

After the tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel to relax and enjoy the evening.

Optional Abu Simbel & Board the Nile Cruise
