Day 1

After your tour, you'll board your luxurious Dahabiya Nile boat and enjoy a delightful lunch as you sail down the serene Nile River. The evening will bring you to **Kom Ombo**, where you will dock and spend the night.

Day 2

Saturday

Later, set sail for a picturesque island. Depending on the weather, dinner will be served on the Sun

Day 1

Monday

Upon arrival in **Luxor**—either at the airport or train station—you will be greeted by your tour manager, who will assist you with all necessary arrangements. Then, embark on a guided tour with an

expert Egyptologist to explore Luxor's iconic sites:

Valley of the Kings: Home to the tombs of ancient pharaohs.

Temple of Hatshepsut: A magnificent structure dedicated to Egypt's most famous female

pharaoh.

Colossi of Memnon: Two towering statues of Amenhotep III.

Karnak Temple: A sprawling complex featuring towering columns and intricate carvings.

After the tour, you'll transfer from Luxor to Esna to board your Nile boat. Spend the night in Esna as

the boat begins its journey down the Nile.

Day 2

Tuesday

Return to the boat for lunch as you continue sailing toward the Silsela Hormoheb Temple. Dinner will be a special experience, served either on the temple grounds, a nearby island, or the boat's top deck,

accompanied by serene music that complements the setting.

Day 3

Wednesday
