


Sonesta Star Goddess Nile Cruise

Day 1

After your tour, you'll board your luxurious Nile cruise boat in Aswan, where you'll enjoy a delicious lunch, sip afternoon tea, and relax as you settle in for an unforgettable overnight stay onboard.

Day 2

Temples of Kom Ombo & Edfu – Sailing the Nile

Later, you'll be transferred to Aswan Airport or the train station for your departure, leaving with memories of a lifetime.
